

Supporting the Parish

We appreciate the support and generosity of everyone who supports the Parish and its Priest throughout the year. Your support is important in maintaining our parish now and into the future. Just a few notes on supporting the parish.

- The big advantage of using the Parish Envelope System is that it enables the parish to keep a record of how much each person contributes.
- The parish can claim the tax element of any P.A.Y.E. or self-employed contribution at 31% at no extra cost to the parishioner. All contributions of €250 or over in any one year is eligible for this extra benefit. In 2020 the Parish received €16,770 in this scheme.
- The weekly offertory envelopes given at the offertory collection funds the parish administration and maintenance.
- All contributions are treated confidentially. If you would like to check your contributions at any time you can do so by contacting the parish office.
- If you are not using the envelope scheme you might consider doing so in the New Year. Information and box of envelopes available from the parish office.
- While the majority of people contribute on a weekly basis some choose to pay a lump sum e.g. every six months or once a year.
- We are indebted to our contact people who distribute the envelopes, our collectors, counters and the generosity and support of our parishioners.
- If you mislay your box of envelopes or have any questions, please contact the parish office at 066-9151208.
- It is also possible to donate to the parish online. Visit dingleparish.ie and click on the donate button. There is a facility to identify what your donation is for and there is an option to make a regular donation.
- If you would like to donate to the parish by standing order contact the parish office for a standing order form.
- The **Income for the Priest** comes from the dues offerings at Spring, Easter, Autumn, November and Christmas, and from the stipends for baptisms, weddings, funerals, and chaplaincies.
