"We must pay special attention to this: the children and the grandparents. Children and young people are the future, they are the strength, those who take us forward. They are the ones in which we place our hope. Grandparents are the memory of a family, they are the ones who gave us the faith, transmitted to us the faith."

"As human beings we are exactly the same. We know that love and peace are the way to a better world. We know that getting along with one another, celebrating our common humanity, appreciating our differences, that's what will move us forward, especially in these troubling times."

"To be ready to serve, we need a healthy heart: a heart healed by God, one which knows forgiveness and is neither closed nor hardened."

"Today people are suffering from poverty, but also from lack of love."

"Love is shown by little things, by attention to small daily signs which make us feel at home."

"Faith grows when it is lived and shaped by love."

"That is why our families, our homes, are true domestic churches. They are the right place for faith to become life, and life to grow in faith." - Pope Francis
